Easy Tips to Maximize Results And To Prolong The Life Cycle Of Microfiber Towels

Your investment in the remarkable MICROFIBER towel will result in benefits unheard of with cotton towels. To maximize the potential of this innovative product and to realize hundreds of washes, follow these guidelines.

- Microfiber towels clean best without using solvents or cleaner. A slightly damp towel works best for streakless cleaning. (If the towel streaks, it is too wet)
- Microfiber towels can be used right out of the box and do not require "breaking in"
- If cleaners are used in conjunction with the towel, use a diluted mixture. Too much cleaner will clog the pores, reducing cleaning and drying capability.
- If the towel leaves streaks, this is a sign that the pores are clogged with too much soap. Wash the towels in vinegar at least twice to clean out the pores and then cut down on your liquid soap usage. 1 ounce of detergent is more than enough for large loads.
- Use of a mild detergent is recommended but never add bleach, fabric softener or any other cleaning chemicals to the wash.
- Wash and dry the towels separate from any other type of towel. Also, remember to clean the lint trap prior to drying.
- Towels can be placed in an electric dryer on low setting, however, Microfiber towels will dry 8 times faster than cloth towels so using a dryer is not always necessary.
